Onsite online registration will also be held on Monday, December 16<sup>th</sup>, from 7:00-8:00 a.m. Conference attendees with completed registrations are invited to the welcome reception on Sunday, December 15<sup>th</sup>, from 5:45 to 6:55 p.m. The symposium ends on Thursday, December 19, 2024, at approximately 10:00 p.m. Cancellation Policy: There is a \$100 non-refundable fee. Prior to Sunday, October 1, 2024, the registration fee minus \$100 will be refunded. After Sunday, October 1, 2024, there are no refunds. Substitutions may be made.

Meeting registration includes access to all sessions, the welcome reception, coffee breaks, and one printed abstract book per registrant. Sessions will be held in the mornings and evenings, with afternoons unscheduled, so that you can plan your leisure activities independently.

# Deadline for Plenary & Poster Abstracts: October 14, 2024

### **Plenary Session**

The plenary session speakers are selected by symposium chairmen on an invitation-only basis. The plenary session features presentations from academic and industrial leaders in the drug delivery field. The symposium is well-known for the important scientific inquiries and discussions held during the plenary and poster sessions. Plenary abstracts will be printed in the Abstract Book.

The symposium also provides extensive opportunities for academic and business discussions, networking, and negotiations that begin at the conference site and continue long after the meeting.

#### Poster Session:

Poster abstracts meeting the deadline will be printed in the Abstract Book. There will be two poster sessions (PS#1 and PS#2) during the meeting, and researchers are invited to present their latest findings in this forum. Online abstracts are due by Monday, **October 14**, **2024.** Abstracts are limited to a ½-page format as a brief overview of your paper. All those accepted into the poster session should bring a printed poster describing the work cited in the abstract.

Acceptance into the poster session also provides the opportunity to be selected to give a five-minute presentation during one of the conference evening poster sessions (followed by five minutes of questions & answers). If you would like to be considered for an oral presentation, please come prepared with a five-minute presentation on your laptop or on a flash, jump, or thumb drive (USB memory stick) so it can loaded onto the conference laptop. Selections for these oral presentations are decided and announced at the conference.

### **Poster Board Dimension and Details**

The poster boards are 4 feet (high/vertical) by 8 feet (long/horizontal) (1.22 m x 2.44m), and you will be using one side of a double-sided board. Your poster must fit within this size board and it may be one large poster or several smaller posters, providing that it does not exceed these dimensions.

### **Daily Format**

The conference will offer morning plenary sessions, evening plenary sessions, and poster sessions. Morning sessions are scheduled from approximately 8:00 a.m. to noon. Afternoons are left open for your leisure pursuits. Evening sessions are scheduled from approximately 7:00 p.m to 10:00 p.m.

### **Roster:**

Registrants will be given a roster of attendees during on-site registration at the conference. Rosters are only provided onsite at the conference.

### **Travel Expenses and Meals**

Meals are not provided by the conference other than the welcome reception and coffee breaks. Attendees are personally responsible for their own travel expenses, including meals, airfare, hotel accommodations, transportation, and any other travel expenses.

## **Official Language and Dress Code**

English is the official language of the symposium. Business casual dress is recommended.

### History

The US-Japan Symposium is typically held every other year. Traditionally, it was held in odd-numbered years. Past symposiums were held in: 1991 (1<sup>st</sup>), 1993 (2<sup>nd</sup>), 1995 (3<sup>rd</sup>), 1997 (4<sup>th</sup>), 1999 (5<sup>th</sup>), 2001 (6<sup>th</sup>), 2003 (7<sup>th</sup>), 2005 (8<sup>th</sup>), 2007 (9<sup>th</sup>), 2009 (10<sup>th</sup>), 2011 (11<sup>th</sup>), 2013 (12<sup>th</sup>), 2015 (13<sup>th</sup>), 2017 (14<sup>th</sup>) and 2019 (15<sup>th</sup>). However, the COVID-19 pandemic interrupted the symposium schedule for several years. December 2024 (16<sup>th</sup>) represents the first symposium held since the pandemic.
